HHL was engaged the State University Construction Fund to develop an updated academic program, and a concept building design for this 90,000 sf institution. Simultaneously, HHL was engaged to develop a similar plan for the EOC in Rochester.

Utilizing SUNY and UB space standards, we developed a new program model to make the program fit the EOC's updated 21st century program goals.

The plan includes assembly space for students and the general public, an academic

commons area and resource center for student/teacher collaboration, classrooms, laboratories, and administrative spaces.

The study included a test build-out of the existing facility, in addition to alternative building designs at other city sites.
