BUFFALO NIAGARA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT PEDESTRIAN UPGRADES

Buffalo, New York

HHL designed improvements for the pedestrian paths, from the parking ramp located in front of the main terminal building. The operator of the airport, the Niagara Frontier Transit Authority, wanted to improve the experience of travelers going to and from the parking and car rental areas. Additionally, they wanted partons to be more protected from rain, snow and wind.

The design study included various glass “canopies” of the pedestrian bridges which link the parking ramp and car rental building to the terminal. Additionally, we designed interior improvements for the stair towers, including a new south-facing wind screen at

the parking ramp level entry to the stair tower.
