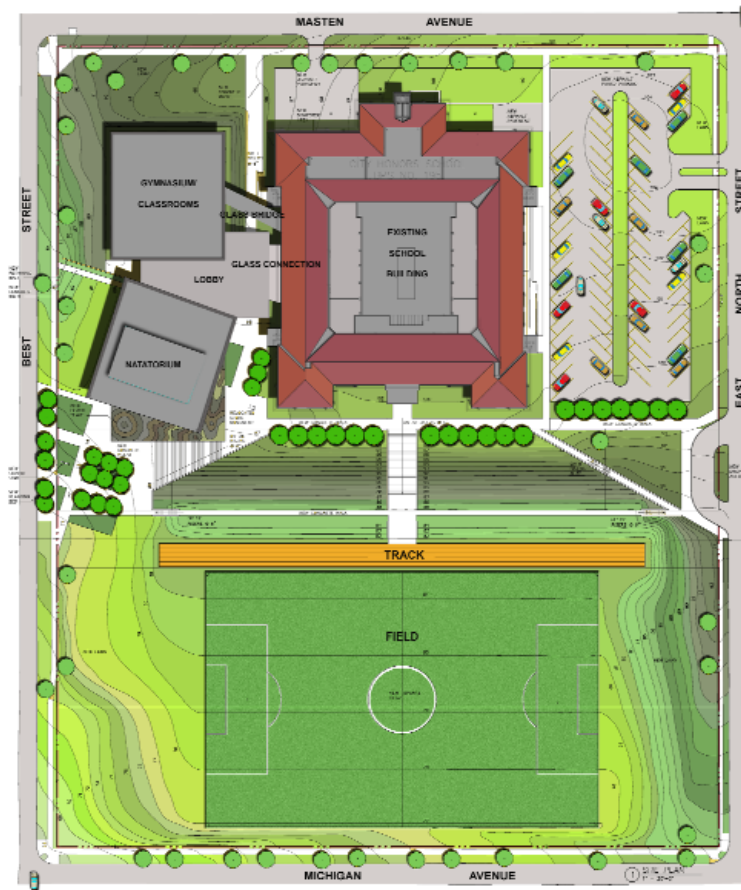

BUFFALO PUBLIC SCHOOL NO. 195 - CITY HONORS Renovation & Addition

Buffalo, New York

Hamilton Houston Lownie Architects, LLC as part of the Buffalo School District Reconstruction Program, designed a model 21st century high school out of existing, antiquated, early 20th century school buildings.

City Honors High School was designed by architect Esenwein and Johnson. The original building consists of a ground, and first thru third floor plans. The 1912 structure is a national landmark building. The new additions comprise a natatorium, gymnasium and science classrooms.

The design solution focuses its attention on the future of the school's science program,

while integrating the national registered structure and the surrounding residential neighborhood.
