## CENTER FOR INQUIRY EXPANSION & RENOVATION

HHL evaluated site opportunities for expanding their headquarters office space. CFI chose to expand their existing building to include additional office, seminar, meeting and entry spaces.

This 14,000 sf, glass and metal, building addition is rotated from the original mass to maximize daylight opportunities. The wood laminated beamed roof is raised and enables daylight to enter the center of the building.

A garden patio separates the new entry and addition from the existing building. This area provides a unique place for contemplation or discussion.

The seminar spaces were designed to accommodate either small, intimate meetings or larger, open group activities by employing movable wall systems.
