EDWARD STREET URBAN PARK STUDY

Buffalo, New York

Hamilton Houston Lownie Architects, LLC, Developed concept plans to rejuvenate a derelict urban park at the juncture of Edward Street, Virginia Street and North & South Elmwood Avenue in the City's Allentown District.

Two (2) options were developed. Concept 'A' focused on creating an improved circulation path through the park, linking North Elmwood with South Elmwood at a central gathering place. Concept 'B' was developed more as a sculpture, based on the idea that an urban park can also be an art form.
