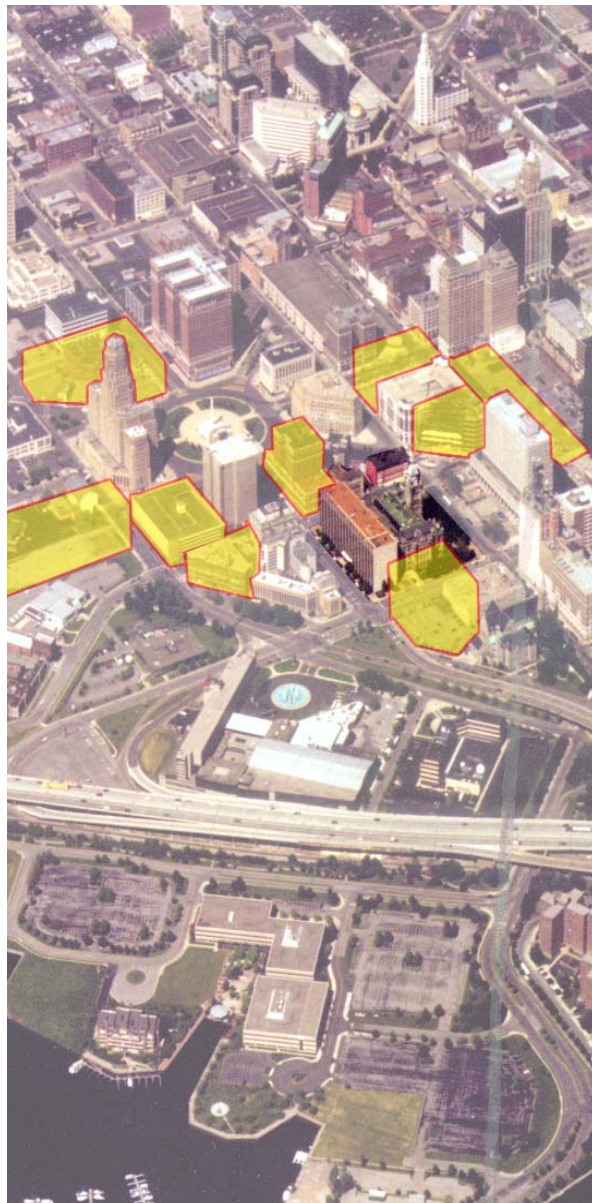

ERIE COUNTY COURTS MASTER PLAN IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT RENOVATION OF OLD COUNTY HALL, 25 DELAWARE AVENUE & 77 WEST EAGLE

Buffalo, New York

HHL prepared a master plan, which included site evaluation and selection, programming and concept building design, for a new Criminal Court Building. The County ultimately decided to use the existing historic Old County Hall campus site for the Criminal Court function. HHL then designed the renovation of the three (3) buildings located on the County campus in Downtown Buffalo.

Old County Hall, a National Register of Historic Places property, was built in 1876 and includes Grover Cleveland's former Mayoral office, was design to be renovated and restored to house the County Legislature, County Clerk, Surrogate Court, Civil Courts and Courts Administration.

The 1960's era, Annex (25 Delaware), was completely renovated to be the primary Courthouse, including: new Criminal Courts, Court Clerk, Jury Selection and the District Attorney The adjacent 77 West Eagle was renovated to serve as the Law Library, including a new Day Care facility.
