The design of this new branch bank was inspired from a historic auto dealership building, which HHL redesigned to be the bank's central offices and main branch.

This new prototype has a corner tower, entry vestibule, with six (6) teller stations, three (3) platform stations, and three (3) drive-up teller lines. This prototype is being used in multiple locations throughout Western New York.

HHL also designed the site and landscape to suit the context of the branch location.
