STURGES HALL ROOF REPLACEMENT

Hamilton Houston Lownie Architects was engaged by the SUCF to design the replacement lead-coated copper roof for this historic, 21,000 sf, landmark Geneseo campus classroom and administrative building.

The roof was completely replaced with a matching standing-seam roof, while gutters and flashings were corrected and repaired. New snow & ice guards were added to the roof membrane.

Brick parapets and stone copings were repaired and pointed as required, and hazardous materials were removed.

Wood double-hung rooftop dormer windows and vents were also replaced as part of the repair and restoration project.
