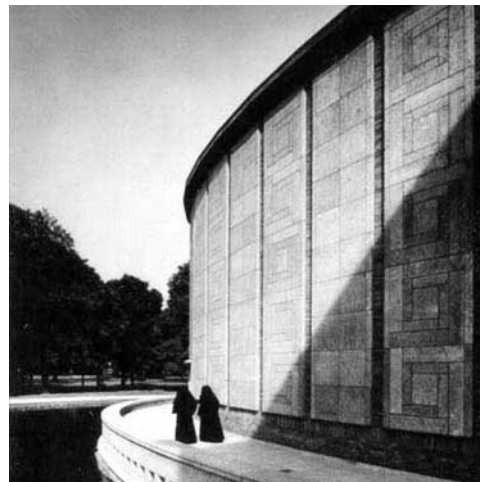

KLEINHANS MUSIC HALL RESTORATION & RECONSTRUCTION

Hamilton Houston Lownie Architects, LLC designed a phased, multi-year restoration and reconstruction of this National Historic Landmark, originally designed by Eliel & Eero Saarinen in 1939.

The Music Hall contains a 3,000 seat concert hall, a smaller chamber music hall, lounge, food service and other support facilities.

The projects included making the building ADA compliant, extensive exterior masonry restoration, complete interior restoration and reconstruction of the reflecting pool.
