MARKET ARCADE COMPLEX RESTORATION & ADAPTIVE REUSE

Buffalo, New York

Design of a mixed use project involving six existing historic structures in Buffalo's Theater District. The centerpiece is the National Landmark, Market Arcade Building, originally designed in 1892 by renowned architects Green & Wicks.

The design uses its three-story, glass-roofed, through-the-block atrium as an entryway to the two adjacent buildings. The complex contains a museum, restaurants, retail, offices, and housing.

Project Cost: \$8,300,000

Completion: Phased 1987 to completion 1995
