HHL designed the new headquarters facilities for the Buffalo Division of the New York State Thruway Authority as an extension of the Authority's function to build roads and roadways that intersect and exchange as a representation of vehicular movement.

The design represents the integration of many passive energy elements in an effort to provide a sustainable structure that fits well within the context of being bounded by wetlands to the South.

The interior space is intended to be flexible and work with the division as it changes

over time. Working with Erdman Anthony Consulting Engineers, this design utilized the LEED rating System in cooperation with the U.S. Green Building Council.
