The Roycroft Campus was the center of the Arts & Crafts movement in the United States for the first third of the 20th Century. Because the campus was home to hundreds of America's finest craftspeople, and the Inn hosted both the famous and ordinary visitors of the day, it was designated a National Historic Landmark in 1974.

HHL designed a restoration of all the primary public spaces and created 22 new guest suites, combining contemporary standards of comfort with the unique historical environment.
