Hamilton Houston Lownie Architects studied this historic church property to assess the utilization of space within the sanctuary/parish hall building, as well as the detached former carriage house, now used as an Early Childhood School.

We then tested three scenarios which created a new entry point as well as possible renovations to improve circulation and accommodate meeting, office and music use space.
